REFUELING SQUADRON COMMANDER CALL SIGN “CHEVRON”

YOUR MISSION:

Provide fuel to airborne aircraft and monitor their fuel state.

AIRCRAFT DESCRIPTION:

The KC-10 Extender is an airline-sized aircraft designed to transfer fuel to other aircraft in flight. The KC-10 should orbit at a safe distance away from threats.

NUMBER OF AIRCRAFT: 2

MISSION SPECIFIC INFORMATION:

1. Each tanker aircraft holds a finite amount of gas represented by 8 fuel chits.
2. You are responsible for distributing fuel (chits) to other aircraft based upon mission requirements.
3. You are responsible for communicating with the other Squadron Commanders to establish their fuel requirements.
4. Notify the group when 15 minutes remain to complete mission planning. Repeat at 5 minutes remaining.
5. You must establish a safe orbit for each of your KC-10s which will accommodate friendly fighters' inflight refueling and isolate yourself from the threats. The KC-10s have no self-protection.
6. You must assign a priority to each Squadron Commander's fuel requirement and distribute fuel chit stickers during the last five minutes of mission planning.
7. Upon completion of your mission planning, complete the enclosed Mission Planning Card.
8. You must control the assignment of fuel chits
9. Any Fighters refueling will do so prior to attacking their targets.
10. Optimum altitude is 22,000 to 26,000 feet.
